Before consenting the patient for FA, please read through the steps.

(Explain the test) Don't read the numbers either

1. Angiography is a procedure to test the health of the retina by injecting the dye in your arm and then take pictures to see how the dye is flowing.

(Explain the color)

- 2. For next 24 to 36 hours, you will notice your skin color a bit yellow and urine color is bright yellow or orange. It is normal.
- 3. Some of the dye may make your stool look green, which is also normal.

(Explain the side effect)

4. about 10% of patients do experience nausea from the dye but usually passes in a minute or two. 1% of patient can experience mild allergic reaction including itchy skin or hives. Rarely 1 in 100,000 patient can experience severe allergic reaction including dizziness and difficulty breathing. If you develop any of these symptoms, please let us know right away, so we can treat you immediately.

(Explain about the burning)

5. Sometimes the dye can come out of the vein, and it may cause a bit of burning. Please let us know and we can help the burning with ice pack.

(Ask the questions)

- 6. Do you have any allergy to food, iodine, or medications? (if yes, notify MD)
- 7. Do you have asthma? (if yes, notify MD)

8. Is there any chance you may be pregnant? or are you nursing a baby currently? (if yes, notify MD)
